





With a profound sense of joy, I embrace another opportunity to greet you in the season of the joyous celebration of the birth of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. This Christmas tradition of lights is a fitting reminder of the prophet Isaiah's portrayal of the coming of Christ into the world. "The people who walk in darkness will see a great light. For those who live in a land of deep darkness, a light will shine" (Isa. 9:2 NLT)

Seemingly, darkness is spreading uncontrollably, with no clear solution available. In his discourse on the incarnation of Christ, John speaks of the power of the light to dispel darkness. "In him was life; and the life was the light of men. The light shineth in the darkness and the darkness apprehended it not." (Jn 1:4-5 ASV). Darkness cannot apprehend light as a police officer can a criminal. When light enters, the darkness is no more.

I borrow from the prophet Isaiah in the sixtieth chapter and make a clarion call to PAWI: "Arise, shine for your light has come. And the glory of the Lord rises upon you. Arise PAWI! This call is not merely to curse the cultural darkness but to light candles. Every assembly must be a shining lighthouse, providing direction to a generation that is loose and drifting from the moorings of our tried-and-true biblical values. Every constituent, wherever you are planted to study, work, play or worship, shine Christ's love and truth in the darkness of sin and hopelessness.

It is humbling to have been tasked with leading this great fellowship in these challenging yet promising times. The resilience and courage of our Credential Workers and assemblies continue to be a source of encouragement and inspiration.
